Treasurers Report was accepted*

Concession:

Home Depot will be used to install the carpeting

Re-Drafting:

Division directors will take care of their own divisions

Games:

Intro & Junior division will not play out of town games (unless Auburn is a possibility)

Intro division will add an extra practice

Have twelve games a season for Intro, Juniors & Seniors

T-Ball & Instructional to keep same scheduling

Intro Division will use older girls to umpire games and have official umpires for play offs

Equipment:

Events:

Family night to be rescheduled to June 14 (Tuesday), with a rain date of June 15 (Wednesday)

Coaches Clinic will not be held this year. CSA will look into this event being held next year, possibly at Nichols College

Pitch, Hit & Run is done before the end of April

A date needs to be set for pictures

Rules Committee:

Rules Committee obligations should be added to the constitution of CSA

As long as *80% of the committee* is in agreement of the rule in question, it does not need to come back to the table

To be brought up to rules committee - starting a new inning at the end of the game -

Should the ruling be changed to NOT *starting* a new inning after 1 hour 45 minutes *into* the game

Rule removal : coaches appointing a spectator to umpire a game

Into/Pitch : *walks* - rule stands -pitcher walks 3rd batter then the coach pitches the rest of the inning

Proposal- a no-walk league -after the 4th ball to one batter, the coach comes in to pitch only to finish the batter up. The pitcher will pitch to the next batter. After the 3rd walk the coach comes in full time to finish the inning. If a batter is hit by a pitch the batter will take the walk to first base.

Juniors: *stealing rule change* - change the rule to unlimited steals to second base and a limit of 3 steals to either 3rd or home base per inning

All-Star Team: If a skilled player moves up to the next division for the season, that player is eligible to be selected for the lower division All-Star Team. (All-Star Team is not a division team it is an age group team)
